Mr. Ward has represented several generic pharmaceutical companies and API manufacturers providing advice with respect to Abbreviated New Drug Application (ANDA) submissions. Mr. Ward has also acted as lead counsel in numerous Hatch-Waxman litigation matters.

During his career, Mr. Ward has participated in many significant intellectual property law cases. He was a member of the team that argued *Morton-International v. Cardinal Chemical*, one of the few patent cases heard by the U.S. Supreme Court in recent years. During that case, the Supreme Court directed the Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit to change the way in which it reviewed patent cases on appeal.
